

This article will give some of the happenings and updates within the community.

New Villages

New villages are under construction in Success Village, Grace Village and finishing out Destiny Village (which will intersect with Huffines Boulevard). Over the coming year, there will be approximately 480 new lots delivered to the builders. We implore residents to please stay off the active construction job sites. The barricades have been installed for safety, so please do not walk, ride or drive around any barricades. These sites are construction zones! Hard hats, safety shoes and high visibility vests and authorization are required. Authorized personnel only will be allowed onsite, so please do not trespass, even after hours.

Club Inspiration

We are now semi-open for business! Come on over and visit the state-of-the-art fitness center and event center. The pool complex will be open shortly and we are looking for a great pool season!

Front Entry

The front entry has experienced issues, several times, with the operation of the water wall. The HOA has had a contractor out on site several times since December 2018 to locate the issue, which seems to be a break in a pipe below the wall. The leak has now been fixed and should not have additional issues. Please notify the HOA if you notice any issues with the water wall, fountains or lighting; as HOA staff is not onsite in the evening hours, when the lights come on.

Landscape

During the construction of the new phases, additional landscaping will continue to be installed around the community. Areas, such as the roundabout and new trails, have now been installed and planted. Additional parks in the new villages are slowly underway. A new dog park is being installed on the north side of Inspiration Blvd., across from the school. Originally, this was to be installed at Club Inspiration, but it needed to be relocated. The sand volleyball was also relocated from Club Inspiration to another park in Wisdom Village and construction is underway.
